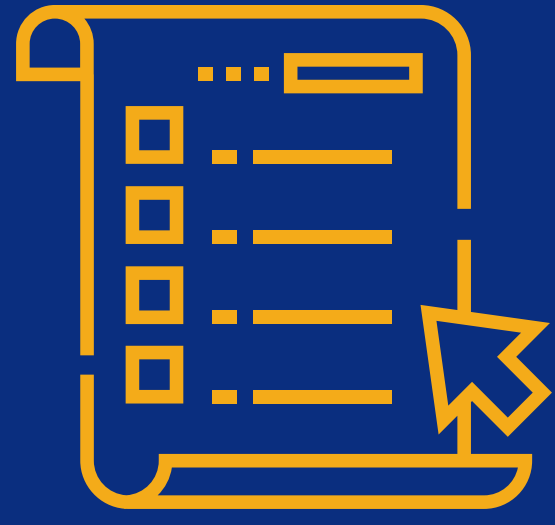

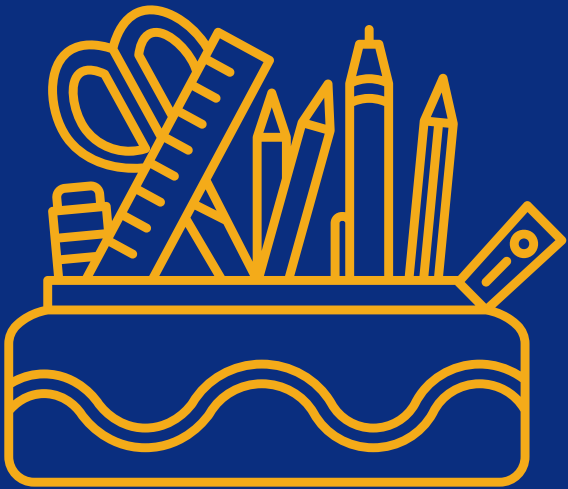

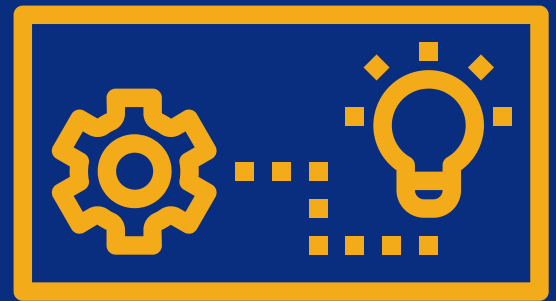
What to bring
