Dress Code

Parking

There are many parking spots around the hotel. Buses and large vehicles are requested to park in the far corner of the parking lot facing the entrance to the hotel. All individual vehicles will need to use parking code **26PKN** to avoid any parking fees. (*Note:* this is a different code from what was published in the Call to Conference).

Competitions

Testing Events: advisers can login to Blue Panda and download testing tickets. All tests must be done by February 20th. Production information will be sent via email to advisers with registered students.

Presentation Events: If your students are in an on-site competition, please ask them to go to the competitive events area 5 minutes before their scheduled presentation or prep time. Individual student competition times will be sent to advisers via email at least one week before the conference, and they will be printed and included in your registration packet.

Lunch

All attendees will receive a meal ticket with your pre-ordered lunches. Box lunches and drinks will be picked up by individuals and can be eaten in any of the hotel dining areas. Students may also want to bring small snacks and a water bottle to stay energized and hydrated throughout the day.

Closing Awards Session

The top four in each competition will be recognized with medals and will automatically qualify to compete at the National Leadership Conference in San Antonio this summer. Advisers will confirm all students' intent to attend NLC by March 27th using a spreadsheet to be sent out after the conference concludes.
