National and State Themes

Competitive Events

National FBLA will not be making any significant changes to competitive events, beyond updating topics and improving the guidelines. All new event guidelines will be posted online in early September. As a reminder, students who scored in the Top Ten for an event at the National Leadership Conference cannot compete in that same event again.

High School State Leadership Conference Eligibility & Hotel Policy

The Colorado FBLA Board of Directors has approved the following updates for the 2027 HS State Leadership Conference:

- The top 3 winners from all events at DLC will be eligible to move forward to compete at SLC.
- Any student/school can opt out of housing at the Gaylord and find their own lodging during the conference.
